Components

13 advanced fish tokens

(1 Giant Squid, 4 Oarfish, 4 Sea Urchin, and 4 Blue Tang)



4 Advanced Fish Token Description cards

Notes on the Advanced Rules

- Until you get used to the game, it is recommended to use only 3 types of advanced fish tokens. (You can choose them randomly or discuss which ones to use.) Once you get used to the game, you may increase the types of tokens to use.
- The cost of additional advanced fish tokens that have moved to the Sea board is the same as the cost for regular fish tokens, namely 2 funds for each token.

Notes on Oarfish

- You can get victory points from Oarfish tokens in addition to the victory points from the Standby track. For example, if your Owner token is in the "2nd" space on the Standby track and you have 33 Oarfish tokens in your Aquarium at the end of the game, you get 2 victory points from the Standby track and 18 victory points from the Oarfish tokens (6 victory points \times 3 tokens), adding up to 20 victory points in total.

Notes on Sea Urchin

- If 1 Sea Urchin token and 1 Seaweed token are placed in the same water tank, the oxygen supply to that tank adds up to 7.
